
President's View—Ron Davis

A Note From Harvey Hosfield:

I retired in December 1986 and found that a group of retired conductors and trainmen who called themselves the "UTU Seniors" were meeting in the Training Centre building behind the CN Depot. There were around 65 of us who discussed our CN Pension, etc. I knew about the CN Vets Division #I which represented the craft personnel and had a membership of around 400. I joined this group and discovered that they did not affiliate with the National Council (NC) of CN Pensioners that CN recognized as the group who represented all CN pension recipients.

I contacted Don Mills, who was the President of the National Council at the time and he suggested I come to their next annual general meeting in Montreal in November 1988 to represent the Winnipeg Seniors. With the help of the Vets President, Borge Gade, George Turnley and George Clements, they passed a motion in their association to re-affiliate with the NC. The National Council was just managing to break even with their membership fee at \$15 paid annually by the members although most of the pensioners did not belong to the NC.

What brought the dramatic turn around of the NC was that the company agreed to a request for the monthly fee (\$1 per month) to be deducted off our monthly pension cheque. Cecil Steeves was persuaded to accept the NC Treasurers job but due to health issues plus the need for computer skills, he decided to give it up. Bruce Peacock of Moncton took over and the rest is history. With the stewardship of our local Treasurer (previously Ernie Borowski and now Jerry Dunford), as well as the enthusiasm of our Membership Chair Wayne Zaharia, our Manitoba Association now has approximately 4000 members.

Please make the job of Treasurer and Membership Chair easier by paying your local fee by pension cheque deducation. Remember, these positions are filled by volunteers who are serving you, so if you are not already on pension cheque deduction, please contact Wayne Zaharia and sign up.
