

Government Contacts for Birthday & Anniversary Certificates

Manitobans celebrating a significant anniversary or birthday can request congratulatory messages from Federal and Provincial (**Manitoba**) Dignitaries through the services of the Province of Manitoba Greetings Branch: [Congratulatory Message Request | The Legislative Assembly of Manitoba \(gov.mb.ca\)](#)

The messages fall into three categories: Birthday, Wedding Anniversary, and Special Messages. Residents of other provinces should contact their provincial government for similar services. Greetings are for residents who are celebrating birthdays of 75 years and up in five-year increments (e.g. 75, 80, 85) and anniversaries starting at 50 years and up in five-year increments (e.g. 55, 60, 65).

Provide the following information in all greeting requests:

- name of celebrant(s), including title (Mr., Mrs., Ms., Dr. etc.)
- address of celebrant(s)
- name and address of who and where to send greetings (if different from above)

Greetings from the Governor General of Canada must be received at least eight weeks prior to the required delivery date.

Greetings from the Mayor of Winnipeg should be received at least 30 days in advance.
