



Special Notice Re the 2020 Bursary Program Sponsored By The CN Pensioners Association of Manitoba

As a result of effects of the Covid-19 Pandemic on the Canadian education system, particularly at the High School Graduate level, please note the following modification to our CNPA of Manitoba sponsored Bursary Programs for 2020. In addition, to help provide some financial relief as a result of the economic impact of Covid-19, the CNPA of Manitoba will be offering 2 additional Harvey Hosfield Bursaries for this year only for a total of 5 bursaries.

High School Graduating Marks:

We recognize there will be a multitude of solutions offered by the varied and many school boards across Canada to resolve the fact school facilities were closed for the last few months of the school year. There will be varied solutions put forward to provide graduating marks to Grade 12 Students or students in CEGEP 1 which will permit them to apply for and if appropriate be accepted into their 1st year of secondary education.

Accordingly, when providing High School Graduation Marks for your scholarship application, full year marks for Grade 11 and first term marks for Grade 12 are required, as well as whatever marks or system of grading are provided by your particular school district for the second term will be accepted by our selection committee.

In Quebec, full last year High School marks and 1st term CEGEP 1 marks along with end of year provision made.

Proof of Registration from an accredited institution is required as per our normal criteria.

A short note should accompany your submission to explain your particular situation. If your school provides a written document outlining their policy, include that as well.

Examples: 1st term marks only provided. Or: 2nd term marks prorated. Or 1st term marks duplicated.

We will thoroughly evaluate all submissions in a fair and consistent manner as always. Please read ALL the instruction package to make your application as strong as possible.
